Afrikan Ridge Merlot – South Africa

Wide bright red rim with red berry on the nose with hints of chocolate developing over time. The palate follows on from the nose with cherry, plum and blackcurrant providing good fruit upfront followed by a firm lingering finish. Overall a smooth well balanced wine.

Afrikan Ridge Sauvignon Blanc – South Africa

Zesty light golden hue with an inviting lively nose displaying appealing fruit with a hint of fresh-cut grass. This well-structured wine has a powerful up-front full mouth feel which follows through with a lingering dry finish.

Cuvee Jean-Paul Gascogne Rosé ~ France

Aromas of crushed berries (soft white and red currants) and appealing fruit flavours. Dry, with a burst of fruit and a refreshing finish. This is an easy drinking fresh rosé with real character.

Solara Orange – Romania

Dark straw colour with orange hints, the nose is a delicate mélange of quince, poire william and a hint of vanilla. A complex and structured wine, with elegant but discreet fruit flavours of stone fruits, backed up with a powerful tannin structure and long finish. A natural minimal intervention wine which is well balanced and structured yet pure and incredibly fresh.

Uva non Grata Gamay ~ France

For centuries maligned, mistreated and misunderstood, Gamay was outlawed by Philip the Bold in 1395. Some vigneron rebelled, hiding forbidden Gamay vines amongst 'noble' Pinot Noir. Bouncy, crunchy Gamay, this is an irresistible fruit bomb packed with fresh, primary fruit aromas and the delicious soft red berry flavours of gorgeous Gamay at its best.

Cellar De Capcanes Sense Cap Blanc – Spain

Attractive yellow golden-green colour. Seductive fruit flavours of peach, pear, mango, and banana. Hints of flowers and herbs: creamy and soft with crispy freshness in the mouth. Medium-bodied, lovely fruit and floral finish.

Felicette Grenache Blanc ~ France

In homage to Felicette, the first cat to travel to space in 1963. An intense but fresh bouquet combining mint, pear, dry apricot and white flowers. A wonderfully fresh palate of mango and a hint of spice leading into a crispy lime zest finish.

Les Chiens Catalans Blanc ~ France

lightly floral on the nose with a hint of minerality and pastry. Honeysuckle, peaches and herbs shine through from the Rousanne supported by lovely texture, depth and weight from the Grenache Blanc. A salivating mouth, which is slightly saline and with juicy pear notes.

Pemo Pecorino Terre di Chieti – Italy

A super fresh and zingy wine bursting with lively citrus acidity, notes of tropical fruits and a hint of minerality, which gives the wine a lovely balance.

Funkstille Skin Contact ~ Austria

A delightful blend of Riesling, Grüner Veltliner, Gewürztraminer and Muscat which offers up notes of ginger, white pepper and flowers, with an underlying hint of green tea and mandarin. Fabulous razor like acidity, gentle tannic grip from the skins and generous fruit with every mouthful.

Pattingham Nurton Brook White Solaris ~ England

Clean, fresh, and excitingly fruit forward, this is the sort of wine to make you sit up and take notice. Pattingham Vineyards' soils have a history of being used for pasture land, so is rich in nutrients that help this Solaris develop. If you're a fan of crisp, fruity, and dry white wines then this is a must try.

Cantina di Soliera Lambrusco Grasparossa – Italy

This traditional off-dry style has lashings of vibrant cherry and berry fruit. Dark ruby red in colour with intense aromas of plum and ripe black cherry. The palate is fresh and vibrant with pure crushed black fruits balanced by fresh acidity and a touch of sweetness. The finish is clean and dry with a nip of tannin.

Levre Piquante Picpoul De Pinet ~ France

A crisp and refreshing white wine with a zesty lemon and lime character.
Perfect for summer days

La Roche Blanche Muscadet Loire ~ France

With a deep, golden colour, this is a charming, full-bodied, Muscadet that has expressive minerality, honey and grapefruit. The palate is punctuated by flattering lemon notes with a light crisp finish.

Ant Moore Signature Series Sauvignon Blanc – New Zealand

A well-rounded Sauvignon Blanc, displaying intense lemon flavours with hints of lime. Full bodied with lovely palate weight and a touch of fruit sweetness and finishing with a persistent intensity.
